

Missouri

Missouri uses a risk-based process to address releases from petroleum storage tanks. Target levels can be found at<u>http://www.dnr.mo.gov/env/hwp/tanks/docs/soiltypedep.pdf.</u> Table 3-1 lists default target levels which are used to indicate whether a release to soil or groundwater has occurred. Tables 7-1(a) – 7-12(c) list clean-up levels based on certain site-specific information. In addition, site-specific target levels can be developed for the site using software approved by Missouri DNR.
